TEACHER: Pastor Garry Nyenhuis **SCRIPTURE:** Acts, Chapter 2

SUMMARY: Wow! Pentecost is simply amazing, isn't it? To see flames of fire sitting on tops of the disciples had to be mind-blowing! Today we will spend time talking about Acts, Chapter 2 and as we do, here are some things to think about and discuss:

- What do you know about Pentecost and the Holy Spirit?
- What have you learned about the third Person of the Trinity and where did that learning come from?

Talk this out with your group or with another believer and be open to learning more about the third Person of the Trinity!

 What is significant about "they were all together in one place" in verse 1?

The Holy Spirit is often confusing and perplexing, and the actions He takes can leave us perplexed (see verses 7 and 8).

- What can we do with our confusion? Is confusion okay? How do we explain to others what we ourselves can't understand?
- What stands out to you from Peter's message (verses 14-39)?
- What is it like to be "cut to the heart?" Have you had this experience? Describe it to someone and/or journal that experience to be able to look back at it later!

Peter's action words are "repent and be baptized!" Don't ignore this call to action and don't ignore what the Holy Spirit is calling you to do today!
