The question for this week is, "How do we give?" The reason this question becomes important is because we seem to have an answer that we often overlook. We aren't told to focus on the setup of offering or the details of offering, but instead HOW OUR HEARTS are to be positioned while we give. Taking notes from the widow that Christ observed, we will get curious about what our hearts look like when we give, what our motive is and what we are truly saying with our actions!
