SUMMARY: Today we start looking at the book of Ruth in the Old Testament! Seeing God's faithfulness and His attention to detail will be primary lessons in this series and so I ask you to pay attention to some of these things in week 1:

1. Where do you see glimpses of Christ and His story in the beginning of this story about Ruth?
2. What character can you relate to in this story and why?
3. In this story, there are several details that at first glance seem random and yet we know are ordained by God; how does that equate to your walk? Do you see the planning of God in the details of your life?

Try this...

1. Make a life map, using a different color for hard times, a different color for good times, etc. Look over the entire map and make remarks on what you learned about God in each scenario. Make times between something that happened and the result. See the planning that God has been doing and notice that it was not random.
2. Practice faithfulness, like Ruth, like God. Ruth's statement in verses 16-17 is a great start for making a promise to Your God. Draw up a covenant with Your God! This is important: know that He is a promise keeper and will stay true even when you can't.
3. Study Ruth! Use RightNow Media, search for Ruth and go through any of the in-depth studies to learn more. Do this with a spouse, friend or by yourself!
