SCRIPTURE: Exodus 33: 12-14

SUMMARY:

This week we begin our LOVE DOES series! We start by looking at Exodus 33:12-14.

For this series, we will be using the book LOVE DOES by Bob Goff as a helpful tool. In the study guide we have some helpful questions to go with this passage; think about some of these:

1. Have someone ever said to you, "I'm with you"? Who was it and what was the occasion? How did it affect you? Have you ever said the same words to someone else? What was that like?
2. What does it mean to you that "God will never quit us"? Does that sound like good news or bad news to you?

As you soak in the reality of "God with us", try some of these things:

1. Join a LOVE DOES small group! If you haven't joined a group yet, contact Pastor Garry to get involved!
2. Read LOVE DOES by Bob Goff. Read about his experiences and see what the Holy Spirit is saying to you through Bob's story.
3. As God has promised to be with you, promise to be with a friend a spouse, a family member or someone God has placed in your life. Actually say the words "I am with you" to them, and then be with them! Stick by their side in a hard time, put away your phone when talking to them. Initiate a meeting with them. Be a close companion!
