WELCOME! We're glad you're here and have decided to join us today!

Lent is a beautiful time of preparing our hearts for Easter, for the death and resurrection of the Son of God. As a sermon series over the next weeks at Living Water, we will walk through the days of Jesus' last week on earth (often called "passion week") taking one day of the week each Sunday.

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 26:6-13

SERMON SUMMARY:

This week we look at Jesus' anointing at Bethany. As we continue through the season of Lent, pay attention to what the Holy Spirit is pointing out to you today!

Feel free to use these sermon points and guestions to help you think about this incredible passage!

- What is important about Jesus' location for this story?
- Which people do you notice in this story?
- Jesus' response is obviously a key to this account; in His response, what does He seem to be saying? Maybe just as important, what isn't He saying?

Here are some possible application points for you to consider: These points are not meant to create shame, nor are they meant to create pride. These questions are meant to help us take inventory of our life!

- Is anything more important than Jesus to you? Really? Would your actions back that answer up? Your time log over the past week? Your money transactions over the past year?
- What have I placed more value on than I should? What have I not placed enough value on? How do I give everything for Jesus? Am I so very in love with Him that I value nothing more?

Try this:

- Spend time falling in love with Jesus again, or maybe for the first time. In Jesus, God shows us an incredible love; a deep love; a ridiculous love. He is so in love with you! If you have run away from Him, if you have never realized His love, if you have taken it for granted-He still loves you! Spend intentional time with God this week, basking in His love.
- Read song of Solomon and hear the longing that the author expresses for their lover-and recognize that deep love is only a glimpse of God's love for you!
- Read the book "Crazy Love" by Francis Chan; it's a great description of the experience of God's love.
- Tell someone about God's love for them. Teaching is one of the greatest ways to learn! Explain to them that God loves them so very much that He gave His only Son. As you are telling them, realize that you are telling yourself, as well!

Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church during the past eight months of our fiscal year (July 2018 – February 2019). Here are a few highlights based off the February 28, 2019 financial statements:

Revenue & Disbursements Update – For the first eight months of this fiscal year (July 2018 – February 2019) we currently have a shortfall of (-\$1,789.83).

* Total Revenue / Income = \$277,040.36

* Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$278,830.19

* Net Increase / (Decrease) = (-\$1,789.83)

LW Cash-Flow Update – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of \$77,057.54 on February 28, 2019.

* It costs LWCC approximately \$1,375 to operate on a daily basis.

* With our cash balances, we have about **56 days** of operating money.

* The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

Building Debt Update - We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for \$100,000. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective. GRACE Update - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2018-19) is \$104,545.00 (55 Students).

* As of February 28, 2019 - we have paid the schools **\$52,571.04 or 50%**. * The remaining balance is \$51.973.96 or 50% as of March 1. 2019.
