SCRIPTURE: Ephesians 6:1-4

SUMMARY: For week 2 of our FAMILY LIFE sermon series, we look at the relationships of parents and children. How do we love like God the Father and obey like Christ the Son? Only through the power of the Holy Spirit!

How do we apply this passage as parents of children, as children of parents, and especially as children of the Lord?

Here are a few ideas:

- 1. Quote Scripture.** All the time. "Talk about these words when you sit, when you walk. Bind these words as a sign on your hand, write it on your doorposts!" Try memorizing a passage with your family!
- 2. Use common sense in your relationships.** Your kindness begets kindness. Treat someone well and notice the difference it makes.
- 3. Train and Instruct.** Set a GREAT example. Make a specific set of goals that you and your family want as characteristics/things that will help you in this battle. What do you need to do to have those things in your set of armor?
