# **TODAY'S TEACHER: Pastor Garry Nyenhuis**

SCRIPTURE: John 3:16-17

SERMON SUMMARY: Our Lent sermon series continues today by answering "Why Easter?" with "Jesus comes to save!" In order to think about that more, we will look at John 3:16-17.

As we study this passage, feel free to use these thoughts as an outline:

- 1. Out of a conversation with Nicodemus, Jesus speaks a convicting truth.
- 2. We are in NEED because our default future WAS "death."
- 3. God's motivating factor was His love.
- 4. He showed His love by giving.
- 5. Our requirement is to believe.
- 6. Our reward is the opposite of death.
- 7. Our challenge is to live in the light of this truth.

#### So, now what?

- 1. Admit your need. In journaling, in prayer, in conversation admit your sins and your sinful nature and admit that you cannot save yourself from the "death" that sin leads to.
- 2. Accept Jesus Christ as your Savior! Only He can save! Not your works, not another "small g" god, not anything or anyone-only the true God! Remember: accepting Him is not just a private thing! Accepting Him is a communal privilege, so share that the Holy Spirit is calling you to accept or reminding you of Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior! Share it with me, with a trusted believer in God, with a church elder or leader and pray together.
- 3. Now that we know we will not experience true death, live in the light! Be aware of what truly matters most (seek first the Kingdom of God!) and don't fall into the traps of this world. Know that He loves You and has saved you and living an "old life" isn't worth it anymore!
