WELCOME! We're glad you're here and have decided to join us today!

Lent is a beautiful time of preparing our hearts for Easter, for the death and resurrection of the Son of God. As a sermon series over the next weeks at Living Water, we will walk through the days of Jesus' last week on earth (often called "passion week") taking one day of the week each Sunday.

SCRIPTURE: Luke 22:1-6

SERMON SUMMARY: This week, as we look at the passage in Luke 22, we come closer and closer to Jesus' crucifixion, His death and His resurrection and we are given a first glimpse of His betraval at the hands of Judas Iscariot. Looking at this passage we can have some very practical questions, like...WHY? Why would someone betray the Son of Man when He had shown nothing but love? Why would a disciple-a friend-not only agree to hand Jesus over, but even initiate a meeting with the chief priests?

Of course, it is easy for us to be on this side of the story and claim disgust for Judas, but is there something larger at work here that we must pay attention to?

Think about these things and discuss them with fellow believers:

• How does this story show the power of Satan?

• How does this story show the power of God?

We will also talk a bit about other Bible stories where God's plan was in place, even while it seemed evil was running rampant.

- Can you think of more examples of God's sovereignty in the Bible?
- What does God's sovereignty mean for your life?

As possibilities for applications, here are some suggestions:

- Make a timeline of your life. Put the good memories in one color and the tough situations in another color. Take time and reflect on how God was and is working in your life! Even if the tough times are recent, take heart-God is working for the good of those who love Him; the "good" might not even be in this life, but someday (as 1 Peter 5:10 says) we will be restored!
- Take time in prayer, asking God to protect you, your family and your church family from the power of the evil one. Take heart, for Jesus has overcome the world!

Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church during the past eight months of our fiscal year (July 2018 – February 2019). Here are a few highlights based off the February 28, 2019 financial statements:

Revenue & Disbursements Update – For the first eight months of this fiscal year (July 2018 – February 2019) we currently have a shortfall of (-\$1,789.83).

- * Total Revenue / Income = \$277,040.36
- * Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$278,830.19

* Net Increase / (Decrease) = (-\$1,789.83)

LW Cash-Flow Update – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of \$77,057.54 on February 28, 2019.

- * It costs LWCC approximately \$1,375 to operate on a daily basis.
- * With our cash balances, we have about **56 days** of operating money.

* The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

Building Debt Update – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for \$100,000. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective. GRACE Update - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2018-19) is \$104,545.00 (55 Students).

* As of February 28, 2019 - we have paid the schools **\$52,571.04 or 50%**.

* The remaining balance is \$51,973.96 or 50% as of March 1, 2019.
