For our study of discipleship this morning, we look at Philippians 3:7-10. Here's some questions to discuss:

- 1. Is there anything you used to consider a gain, but now consider loss?
- What in your life right now is challenging Christ for being the greatest thing?
 What does it mean to you to "know Christ?" What does it mean to "gain
- Christ?"
- 4. Are you willing to know His power, to share in His suffering, and to become like Him in His death?

As you go throughout your week, here are some suggestions for application:

- 1. Prayerfully consider what is too high on your priority list. Maybe it is a job, a person or even a hopeful dream. What would it look like to purposefully place that thing below God and to give Him first priority?
- 2. Write a personal mission statement. This set of verses is a great launching pad for this opportunity. If not a mission statement, then how about a life verse? Write this statement or verse in several prominent places. Talk about it with someone close to you. Memorize it and use it throughout the week.
