SCRIPTURE: Deuteronomy 26:1-11

SERMON SUMMARY: The holidays are coming! As we move into the holiday season, we're going to be looking at holidays from the Bible. One common theme that we'll find as we dive into these celebrations is that our response to God's goodness almost always involves the act of giving back. This morning, we're looking at the Celebration of Firstfruits. This was celebrated at the beginning of harvest time. Having just gone through harvest ourselves, this is a relevant and timely message for us as well. **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**:

- What stories of embarrassment or success does your family tell about your ancestors?
- Where are you sometimes tempted to see your gifts and success as your own? Health? Financial? Athletic? Academic? Family?
- What reactions do you have to the idea of giving back to God before the harvest is even gathered in?
- What does this look like for those of us who aren't farmers?

LIFE APPLICATION:

- Spend some time looking back at your family tree. Pay special attention to any areas of struggle, difficulty, or things that might otherwise be embarrassing. Also pay attention to how God has been working in your families through the generations to bring you to this point today.
- Special note: If your ancestors haven't had a relationship with God, note the ways that He is changing that in you!
- If it feels like things aren't in a good spot right now, ask for a broader perspective of what God might be doing through your life and in the generations to come.
- Consider what it looks like to offer your firstfruits to God; trusting Him to continue providing even through it isn't all gathered in yet. Take a step of faith!
