**SCRIPTURE: John 6:65-69**

**SUMMARY:** Remember that last week we talked about overcoming the things that hold us back from responding well. My hope is that after that discussion and after a full week, you have had the opportunity to face those things head on in the power of the Holy Spirit and are now ready to respond fully to God's good news of grace! And so this week, in part 3 of our "Worship" sermon series, we look at John 6:65-69. In looking at that passage we will try to understand the different ways of responding to God's love and God's challenge. Jesus gives the incredible news and many disciples desert Him. But Peter and the twelve stay around and their reason is centered on these words from Peter: "Where else would we go!? You have the words of eternal life."

As we look at the importance of Peter's response, we will also look at several other examples of responding to God in our scriptures. A few examples include Sarah, Isaiah, Mary and, of course, Peter and the disciples.

Maybe good questions for each of us are:

- ⇒ Who do you relate to the most, in terms of response?
  - ⇒ Are you flabbergasted at the offer of grace? Are you shocked with disbelief? Are you willing to accept it?
  - ⇒ Are you ready to give Him your all in response?
- Be honest with your responses and share them with a small group, a close friend or a trusted mentor. Be willing to ask: "Why do I respond that way?" and be willing to go deeper with Christ to find His answers.

The big idea is to respond without holding anything back; we hope to respond by offering Him our everything and realizing that we have nowhere else to go. May God bless you as you strive to fully and completely follow Jesus by loving God and loving others!
