SCRIPTURE: Jonah 3

SUMMARY: Today we get into the 3rd chapter of Jonah, focusing on the second chance God gives the prophet. As Jonah declares God's coming judgement, the people of Nineveh turn from their wicked ways, repenting of their sins. This story can give us many life lessons and can ask us several things about our walk with God; think about these, for instance:

- ⇒ WHY have you been saved from the torment of hell? For what purpose?
- ⇒ Do you need to have your life and your message perfected BEFORE you attempt to tell someone about the gospel of Jesus Christ? Why or why not?
- ⇒ What does it mean to you to REPENT? What is involved in repentance?
- ⇒ What outcome do you believe will happen when you repent? Is that outcome a promise of God?
- ⇒ What does God's COMPASSION mean to you? Do you have real life examples?

Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church. Here are a few highlights based off the May 31, 2018 financial statements:

Revenue & Disbursements Update – For the first eleven months of this fiscal year (July 2017 – May 2018) we currently have a deficit of (-\$535.79).

- Total Revenue / Income = \$447,478.25
- Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$448,014.04
- Net Increase / (Decrease) = (-\$535.79)

LW Cash-Flow Update – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of **\$92,441.27** on May 31, 2018.

- It costs LWCC approximately **\$1,375** to operate on a daily basis.
- With our cash balances, we have about **67 days** of operating money.
- The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

Building Debt Update – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for **\$100,000**. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective.

GRACE Update - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2017-18) is **\$106,462.64 (60 Students)**.

- As of June 11, 2018 - we have paid the schools **\$93,799.58 or 88%**.
- The remaining balance is **\$12,663.06 or 12%** as of June 12, 2018.

Please remember LWCC in your giving the next 2 weeks (Sunday, June 17 and Sunday, June 24). Our fiscal-year-end is on Saturday, June 30, 2018.

The Stewardship Team
