SERMON SUMMARY: Blessings and Woes

This week, we begin a new sermon series, THE SERMON ON THE PLAIN, with teachings that call us to be counter cultural according to Jesus' instructions.

SCRIPTURE: We start with Luke 6:20-26. As we read through these blessings and woes, consider these questions:

- ⇒ List out the blessings and list out the woes, next to each other. What do you notice as similarities and what do you notice as differences?
- ⇒ What does it look like to be poor, hungry, weeping, and hated by this world? What does it look like to be rich, well fed, laughing and spoken well of?
- ⇒ Looking at your life goals and aspirations, which side do they equate more with?

Think about these applications:

- Recognize that God is in the business of blessing people, but sometimes we misunderstand what blessings look like. Pay attention to how you are blessed not only in this life, but in the life to come.
- ⇒ Don't get comfortable with this life. Allow yourself to be in a situation that causes you to be the poor, hungry, weeping and hated person.
- ⇒ Maybe you are poor, hungry, weeping and hated. Then take comfort. This is not all there is. Your reward is not this life, it is the life to come.
