Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous support of the ministries of Living Water Community Church. As a church, we are passionate about helping Christian's be managers of all of God's gifts. We continue to be blessed financially at LWCC. Here are a few highlights:

<u>LW Cash-Flow Update</u> – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a current cash position of \$86,743.98 on October 31, 2017.

· It costs LWCC approximately \$1,300 to operate on a daily basis

· So with our cash balances, we have about 67 days of operating money

 \cdot The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash

<u>Building Debt Update</u> – We currently have one loan-one to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for \$100,000.

 \cdot Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong

 \cdot We are very healthy from a debt perspective

<u>GRACE/Fair Share Update</u> – Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2017-18) is \$104,862 (59 Students).

• As of October 31, we have paid the schools \$31,000 or 30%

The remaining balance is \$73,862 or 70% as of October 31, 2017
