- If that is who you (who we all) really are, what is the message of hope for you in the "marvelous joke" of the Easter story?

LIFE APPLICATION:

- Celebrate this Easter by doing something unexpectedly ridiculous to bless somebody else.
- Read a chapter about Jesus in Luke. Look for God's sense of humor coming through.
- Look honestly at your own life and pay special attention to where God's foolishness has been even better than you could have imagined.

Stewardship Team Update - Thank you for your generous support of the ministries of Living Water Community Church. Here are a few highlights:

Revenue & Disbursements Update – For the first eight months of this fiscal year (July 2017 – February 2018) we currently have a short-fall of (**\$7,092.33**). Total Revenue / Income = \$319,845.56; Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$326,937.89; Net Increase / (Decrease) = (\$7,092.33)

LW Cash-Flow Update – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of **\$99,942.38** on February 28, 2018. It costs LWCC approximately **\$1,375** to operate on a daily basis; With our cash balances, we have about 72 days of operating money; The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

Building Debt Update – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for **\$100,000**. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong.
