SERMON SUMMARY: This week, as we wrap up our RADICAL OBEDIENCE series, we look to Jonah and see if we can grab some lessons from a prophet who didn't seem to figure out what God really wanted. Even after Jonah says yes and takes action, there is still animosity and anger towards people. What can we learn from that? Maybe more than we think!

SCRIPTURE: Jonah 3:1-3

Focusing on get curious about some of these things:

- What do we know about Jonah?
- What do we know about Jonah's actions before Chapter 3?
- What do we know about Nineveh? Why was Jonah unwilling to go there?
- What message was God giving Jonah to preach?
- Does Jonah obey? I mean, really obey?

As we study, let God penetrate your heart today with Jonah's story. Maybe these are a few ways to apply the passage and discuss Jonah's story with a group:

- Can you relate to Jonah? How and in what ways?
- Does obeying God have a sense of action and a sense of internal change? So did Jonah actually obey, or was he doing it for "the wrong reasons?" What is the difference?
- Can God work through a person's "wrong reasons" (for more discussion on this, look up Philippians 1:15-18 or maybe Genesis 50:20 and talk about how those passages have something to say to Jonah's story).
- What does Jonah's story teach you about God? What does it teach you about yourself?
