**TEACHER**: Pastor Garry Nyenhuis **SCRIPTURE**: Luke 22:19-20

**SERMON SUMMARY**: Lent is a beautiful time of preparing our hearts for Easter, for the death and resurrection of the Son of God. As a sermon series we are walking through the days of Jesus' last week on earth (often called "passion week") taking one day of the week each Sunday. Today we are looking at Thursday of passion week. The words of Luke 22:19-20 are familiar and the sacrament can seem like an old ritual, but be reminded that this an extremely important meal, not only because of what is going to happen afterwards, but because of what is taking place in that moment!

There is so much happening here in terms of symbolism and historical reminders and we can only touch on a couple of the points; so for our time today we will focus especially on these words:

1)"take it; this is my body" and 2) "this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many."

Then get curious with me and ask:

- Why use words like "body" and "blood?"
- What is He offering to His disciples and what is He offering to us? Is it just bread and wine? Is it deeper?
- What is a covenant? Why does He use this word?

As we discuss His words, what would it look like to try some of these things as applications?

- Take communion slowly and purposefully, allowing God to speak through the sacrament and hearing Him in a way you haven't heard Him before.
- Talk about the Last Supper during supper! What is it about a meal that creates community? What kind of community is Jesus wanting to create with you?
- Have you said yes or no to His offer of a new covenant?
