SCRIPTURE: Mark 2:13-17

SERMON SUMMARY:

In today's scripture we see that Jesus spends His time with tax collectors and sinners. What does this passage have to do with us today and what can it mean in our lives? Get curious about some of these questions:

• Why are people drawn to Jesus in this passage?

- What do we know about Levi's situation?
- What is the importance of having dinner?
- What do the Pharisees and teachers of the law ask Jesus' disciples?
- Why is Jesus' response important for us, no matter what stage of life we are in and what stage of faith we are in?

As we wrestle with this passage, here are some possible action steps. Through conversation with the Holy Spirit, determine how to move forward with the information from Mark 2:13-17;

- What stage of faith are you in? Be honest with yourself and with God. Be honest with a trusted brother or sister in Christ!
- How "fit" are you when it comes to your faith? Use the inventory that we'll be discussing today to pinpoint areas of growth. Keep exercising!
- Define sanctification in your own words. Write it down and then put it to the side; check back in another 6 months and see if that is how you would continue to define it.
