- ⇒ What is the good work Paul is talking about?
- ⇒ What does completion mean in Paul's mind? How does that differ from culture's view of completion?

- ⇒ Think of your definition of success. How does that match up with God's?
- ⇒ Take some time to look over the series and the *Messy Spirituality* book. How has God been working in you through this? Share it with me or with a church leader!

STEWARDSHIP TEAM UPDATE

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church. Here are a few highlights based off the May 31, 2019 financial statements:

Revenue & Disbursements Update – For the first eleven months of this fiscal year (July 2018 – May 2019) we currently have a shortfall of **(-\$22,554.73)**.

- Total Revenue / Income = \$391,062.78
- Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$413,617.51
- Net Increase / (Decrease) = (-\$22,554.73)

LW Cash-Flow Update – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of **\$56,623.94** on May 31, 2019.

- It costs LWCC approximately **\$1,185** to operate on a daily basis.
- With our cash balances, we have about **48 days** of operating money.
- The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

Building Debt Update – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for **\$100,000**. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective.

GRACE Update - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2018-19) is **\$104,545.00 (55 Students)**.

- As of May 31, 2019 - we have paid the schools **\$82,241.04 or 79%**.
- The remaining balance is **\$22,303.96 or 21%** as of June 1, 2019.
