## **TEACHER:** Pastor Garry Nyenhuis

#### SCRIPTURE: Genesis 28

**SUMMARY**: We continue in our Advent series by looking at the promises God makes to His people in the Old Testament. This week, we review God's promises to Jacob in Genesis 28.

#### As we discuss, use this as an outline and summary:

- 1. Jacob was running.
- 2. God meets Jacob in a certain place.
- 3. God makes promises to Jacob.

#### 4. Jacob responds.

The word of God is living and active, and it has something to speak into your life today; it can remind, challenge, correct, and encourage! So, what is the Holy Spirit doing in you as we read through this passage? **Maybe...** 

**1....you have been running.** Is it time to stop? Is there something you must confess to God and to a brother or sister in Christ that you have been running from? Is there a conversation you need to have, is there something you need to do? What does it look like for you to stop running?

**2.** ...God is ready to meet you in a certain place. Remember that He has been described as the "hound of heaven." He loves you so much that He is willing and able to chase you to the highest highs and the lowest lows.

**3. ...you need assurance of His promises.** The words He speaks to Jacob are words He speaks to us. Imagine Him speaking to you in this way: "(your name here), I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go!"

**4.**...**it**'s time for you to respond! Maybe you have known the promises, maybe you have already met Him. Maybe you haven't been running. Then maybe it is time for you to respond! Declare His glory with your words! Declare His glory by "setting up a pillar!" Make a response vow to Him this morning and-with the power of His Holy Spirit-carry through and continue on the journey!

## Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church. The following are a few highlights based off the October 31, 2019 financial statements:

**<u>Revenue & Disbursements Update</u>** – For the first four months of this fiscal year (July – October) we currently have a balance of **\$4,370.56**.

- Total Revenue / Income = \$128,243.67
- Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$123,873.11
- Net Increase / (Decrease) = \$4,370.56

**LW Cash-Flow Update** – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of **\$73,286.17** on October 31, 2019.

- · It costs LWCC approximately **\$1,070** to operate on a daily basis.
- With our cash balances, we have about **68 days** of operating money.

• The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

**<u>Building Debt Update</u>** – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for **\$100,000**. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective.

<u>GRACE Update</u> - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2019-20) is **\$99,072.00 (51 Students).** 

• As of November 15, 2019 - we have paid the schools **\$19,520.00** or **20%**.

•The remaining balance is **\$79,552.00 or 80%** as of November 16, 2019.
