SCRIPTURE: 2 Samuel 7

It is December 22 and we are getting so close to Christmas day! Are you excited? Are you nervous? Are you anticipating a big celebration? Are you looking forward to a quiet moment? Are you ready?

The closer we come to the day designated to remember Jesus' birth, it seems more difficult to actually remember Jesus birth. We are distracted, busy, or overwhelmed. We could be saddened by what goes on around us, we could be disappointed by strained relationships or by commercializing the season.

So today, on the third Sunday of advent, just days before Christmas, I'd like to invite you to pause and seek God. Take a moment with me and look at His word in 2 Samuel 7.

Here, just like us, David desires something good; but he finds out that isn't God's plan. Let's especially pay attention to verse 16 this morning, another promise God makes in this Advent season. As we focus on this verse, think about these questions:

Why not David? Why the mention of punishment for the next generation? What does it mean to have a throne forever? What does God do to "prove His point?"

And maybe the Holy Spirit is calling you to think of something like this: What promise has God reminded you of during this advent season? What are you being called to wait on? What are you being told to take responsibility for? What are you leaving as your legacy?

Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church. Here are a few highlights based off the November 30, 2019 financial statements:

<u>Revenue & Disbursements Update</u> – For the first five months of this fiscal vear (July – November) we currently have a balance of **\$10,577.94**.

- Total Revenue / Income = \$165,459.70
- Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$154,881.76
- Net Increase / (Decrease) = \$10,577.94

<u>LW Cash-Flow Update</u> – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of **\$98,522.19** on November 30, 2019.

- It costs LWCC approximately **\$1,035** to operate on a daily basis.
- With our cash balances, we have about **95 days** of operating money.

• The Stewardship Team's goal is to have greater than 75 days of operating cash.

<u>Building Debt Update</u> – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for **\$100,000**. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective.

<u>GRACE Update</u> - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2019-20) is **\$99,072.00 (51 Students).**

- As of December 8, 2019 we have paid the schools \$32,460.00 or 33%.
- The remaining balance is **\$66,612.00 or 67**% as of December 9, 2019.
