Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church. Here are a few highlights based off the December 31, 2019 financial statements:

<u>Revenue & Disbursements Update</u> – For the first six months of this fiscal year (July – December) we currently have a balance of \$4,700.74.

- Total Revenue / Income = \$197,527.62
- Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$192,826.88
- Net Increase / (Decrease) = \$4,700.74

<u>LW Cash-Flow Update</u> – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of \$73,526.35 on December 31, 2019.

- It costs LWCC approximately \$1,075 to operate on a daily basis.
- With our cash balances, we have about **68 days** of operating money.
- The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

<u>Building Debt Update</u> – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for \$100,000. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective.

<u>GRACE Update</u> - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2019-20) is \$99,072.00 (51 Students).

- As of January 10, 2020 we have paid the schools \$32,460.00 or 33%.
- \bullet The remaining balance is \$66,612.00 or 67% as of January 11, 2020.
