WELCOME! We're glad you're here and have decided to join us today!

Next Sunday our congregation will be celebrating the Lord's Supper. This week as we personally consider, "Am I ready to take the Lord's Supper in faith" there are questions that are important for each of us to answer:

- **Have I confessed my sin to God and do I trust Jesus as the only One who can save me from it?**
- **Am I eager to obey Jesus and let Him be my Lord?**
- **Have I sought forgiveness and reconciliation from those I have wronged?**
- **Have I forgiven and reconciled with those who have wronged me?**

TEACHER: Garry Nyenhuis

SUMMARY: Today we look at the story of Noah again looking for clues of Jesus and what He has done for us. As we look at this familiar story, think of the following: We've been reminded of some of Jesus' attributes by looking at the story of Noah.

- **What attribute of Jesus sticks out to you today?**
- **What attribute did you need to be reminded of? Why?**
- **Share your experience of knowing Jesus as a righteous man, as a Savior, or as a sacrificial lamb with someone close to you. Discuss what it means for them to see Jesus in that light.**

NOTES:
