SCRIPTURE: Genesis 39:11-20a

Extra Reading: Luke 23:1-5, Luke 23:39-42

SUMMARY: In movies, an Easter egg is a hidden detail that points to something else. If you look closely enough you can catch these inside references placed there by the writers and directors. We can see similar Easter eggs hidden throughout Scripture that point to the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus. In these weeks leading up to Easter, we'll be hunting through the Old Testament for some Easter Eggs in common stories. This week's hunt takes us to Genesis 39 where we see Joseph falsely accused and sentenced.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- When have you experienced the natural consequences of your own bad choices?
- Where have you struggled/suffered unjustly?
- What has God done or might God still do through that experience?
- What thoughts or feelings does the story of Jesus' unjust suffering and death stir up in you?

LIFE APPLICATION:

- Spend time reflecting and praying through the story of Jesus' trial and crucifixion. Focus especially on His innocence throughout the different events.
- Look for 3 instances of injustice in the world today. Explore what efforts are already taking place to birth something redemptive from those bad situations. Consider becoming involved in one of those efforts.
- Let the shortcomings in yourself and in the world around you lead you to pray the thief's prayer for a more just and redemptive world, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."
